2018 Spring News Letter



Recycling in the Borough of Berwick is mandated to recycle through PA Act 101 of 1988. Residents, including businesses are **required to recycle at least three (3) items**. What you use the most is what you should recycle. We encourage everyone to recycle more than three (3) items because higher recycling totals reduce landfill space, is environmentally friendly, and allows the Borough to receive more grant funding which saves residents money. It is much easier to recycle today since all recyclables can be commingled. Recycling is picked-up at curbside for residential properties or can be dropped-off at the Test Track Park drop off site. Please check the recycling schedule for your curbside pick-up date. So please, recycle!

Our Recycling Contract with KNORR HAULING includes curbside pick-up and drop-off services. Residents can take recycling to the Test Track Recycling and Compost Site. The drop-off site is open 1:00pm-7:00pm every Tuesday, April to September. From October to March the site will be open every Tuesday from 1:00pm to 5:00pm. You must show valid picture ID at the drop-off site to verify your residency.

**NO LEAF OR YARD WASTE BURNING IN THE

Ever wonder what "WARD" you live in?

Well we have a simple way to help you figure it out! First remember that the Borough of Berwick is broken up into four wards. The 1st ward is from the eastern point of the Borough (Salem Township) to the east side of Market Street. The 2nd Ward is from the west side of Market Street to Oak Street. The 3rd Ward is from west of Oak Street to Warren Street. The 4th Ward is west of Warren Street to the Borough line.

SPRING BRUSH PICK UP

The Borough of Berwick will pick up brush at curbside on the below dates:

1st WARD Monday April 30, 2018

2nd WARD Tuesday May 1, 2018

3rd WARD Wednesday May 2, 2018

4th WARD Thursday May 3, 2018

- Limbs cannot be larger than 8" in diameter.
- The Borough will only pick up brush on these days.
- Brush must be at curbside no later than 7am on the day of pick-up.
- Residents may also drop off brush and leaves at the Test Track Recycling Compost site on Tuesdays from 1pm - 5pm.
- **Failure to follow the above provisions shall result in no collection at your home.**

Spring time is coming! Just a reminder to all residents to keep their grass cut below 8 inches in height. The borough has passed a property violation ticket ordinance where warnings DO NOT have to be given for a ticket to be issued if there is a property violation. Ticket fines range between \$25.00 and \$300.00. Ticket can be given for violations such as high grass, sanitation, illegal motor vehicles, rubbish, garbage, containers, prohibited furniture and snow removal.
