§ 119-1. Littering unlawful. [Amended 11-18-1974 by Ord. No. 1087]

No person shall throw, dump or sweep, or permit to be thrown, dumped or swept, any waste materials, refuse, trash or garbage on or upon any of the sidewalks, streets, highways, alleys or thoroughfares of the Borough of Berwick, or upon any property or land adjacent thereto, or into any receptacle located upon or adjacent to such sidewalks, streets, highways, alleys or thoroughfares in the Borough of Berwick, provided that this chapter shall not prohibit the placing of such material in receptacles provided for the deposit therein of the same.

§ 119-2. Violations and penalties.¹

Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall, for each and every offense, upon conviction before the District Justice, pay a fine of not less than \$5 nor more than \$300, and in default thereof, shall be imprisoned for a period of 30 days.
