Chapter 1
GENERAL PROVISIONS

§ 6-1. Authorization to file.

The proper officers are hereby authorized and directed to enter and file in the Office of the Prothonotary of the County of Columbia, in the manner provided by law for the filing of municipal claims, at any time within six months after July 28, 1941, any municipal claims assessed against any property in any case in which the liens were not filed within the time limit required by law for such filing whereby the lien for such claim had been lost.

§ 6-2. Claims to be lien on property.

Such claims shall be a lien on such property assessed, together with all charges, expenses and fees added thereto for failure to pay promptly, and the same are hereby ratified, confirmed and declared valid in accordance with the Act of July 28, 1941, being Act No. 223.¹

§ 6-3. Liens subject to statutory provisions.

Such liens as may be filed pursuant to this chapter shall be subject to all of the provisions of the aforementioned Act.
